Would you like a DOGGY BAG?

When you eat out in Britain, don't be surprised if you hear a waiter asking: 'Would you like a doggy bag?' Some clients immediately say, 'Yes, I'd like (1) ---'. (2) --- people, possibly foreigners, will ask, 'What exactly is a doggy bag?'



It is a bag for the leftovers, that is the food that you couldn't finish in the restaurant. If you are full and feel you couldn't eat (3) --- bite, you can take the food home and enjoy it later. This way it isn't wasted.

As part of an initiative against food waste, the Scottish government decided to give away free doggy bags to restaurants. The (4) --- that offered the doggy bags to their clients had to throw away much less food. Research shows that a lot of people like the idea of a doggy bag, but some of them don't ask for (5) --- because they are embarrassed.

Doggy bags are not a new invention. They became popular in the USA in the 1940s, when times were hard and pet owners started taking leftovers for their dogs. Then, people began using the bags to take the food home for themselves, but the name didn't change. Some people don't like it very much and would prefer (6) --- name, a more elegant (7) ---.
