Transport in Liverpool



Liverpool is a city in the north west of England. It's on the River Mersey. There are lots of interesting places to visit, for example, there are museums, art galleries and Anfield Stadium. To visit all these different places you need to plan your trip, but in Liverpool, you can travel by bus, train or boat. Here are a few ideas ...

Do you want to see the city quickly? You can take one of Liverpool's buses and see lots of the city. The buses go to places of interest inside and outside the city. You can also take the special tourist bus and hear a guide talk about the city.

Lots of people take ferry boats and visit towns nearby, like Birkenhead and Wallasey. Some workers use the ferry every day to go to work. The ferry is over 100 years old. It's a great way to travel across the River Mersey on a sunny day.

Do you like to do things slowly? You can also see the city on foot. It's free! There are special walking tours of Liverpool for tourists. The guides tell you about the city's history. You can also do your own walking tour with a map.
