

- 6- "a great flow of water that rises and spreads over the land"
- 7- "a cyclone formed in the tropics with winds of 74 miles (119 kilometers) per hour or greater that is usually accompanied by rain, thunder, and lightning"
- 8- "a great sea wave produced especially by an earthquake or volcanic eruption under the sea"
- 9- a shaking or trembling of a portion of the earth
- 10- "a period of unusually hot weather"
