**Sue:** What's that?

**Jay:** I don't know.

## Comprehension question

Who says *hello*? (Tiger)

- Sue:** Can I have this pen, please?
- Mum:** Yes, of course. Put it in the basket.
- Sue:** Thank you.
- Jay:** Can I have this pencil, please?
- Mum:** Yes, of course. Put it in the basket.
- Jay:** Thank you.
- Tiger:** Psst! Hello! Grrr! Put me in the basket, too.

## Comprehension questions

What does Sue ask for? (a pen)

What does Jay ask for? (a pencil)

- Jay:** Can I have this pencil case, please?
- Mum:** Yes, of course. Put it in the basket.
- Jay:** Thank you.
- Sue:** Can I have this bag, please?
- Mum:** Yes, of course. Put it in the basket.
- Sue:** Thank you.

What does Sue ask for? (a bag)

- Jay:** Can I have this rubber, please?
- Mum:** Yes, of course. Put it in the basket.
- Jay:** Thank you.
- Tiger:** Psst! Hello! Grrr! Put me in the basket, too.

## Comprehension questions

What does Sue ask for? (a ruler)

What does Jay ask for? (a rubber)





# Welcome to School

**Cashier:** Look! You win a free toy.

**Sue:** A new toy. Great!

**Jay:** Amazing!

**Tiger:** Psst! Hello! Grrr! Please choose me.

## Comprehension question

Sue and Jay win a free toy. Who asks to go with Sue and Jay? (Tiger)





# Welcome to School

- Jay:** Are you a toy?
- Tiger:** Yes, I am.
- Sue:** Are you real?
- Tiger:** Yes, I am. I'm real and I'm a toy. My name is Tiger.
- Mum:** Come on, Sue and Jay. Hurry now.
- Sue and Jay:** Look, Mum. We want this tiger!
- Mum:** Ahh! That's a nice toy!

## Comprehension questions

Is Tiger a toy? (yes)

Is Tiger real? (yes)

Do Sue and Jay want Tiger? (yes)





# Welcome to School


**Tiger:** Hurray! Hello, Sue. Hello, Jay.

**Sue and Jay:** Hello, Tiger!

## Comprehension questions

Is Tiger happy? (yes)

Are Sue and Jay happy? (yes)






# The Gingerbread Man

**Mum:** You make a gingerbread man like this. This is the head. This is the body. And these are the arms and legs.

## Comprehension question

What body parts has the gingerbread man got here?  
(a head, a body, arms, legs)





# The Gingerbread Man

**Jay:** And look. This is the nose. This is the mouth.

**Sue:** And these are the eyes.

**Jay:** The gingerbread man is great.


**Tiger:** Mmm. I'm hungry.

**Jay:** Shh, Tiger! The gingerbread man isn't for you.

## Comprehension questions

What body parts has the gingerbread man got now? (a nose, a mouth, eyes)

Who is hungry? (Tiger)





# The Gingerbread Man

**Gingerbread man:** Look at me! I've got a head. I've got eyes, a nose and a mouth. I've got a body. I've got arms and legs.

Oh no! It's a tiger. I'm off!

## Comprehension questions

Who does the gingerbread man see? (Tiger)





# The Gingerbread Man


**Gingerbread man:** Run, run as fast as you can.  
You can't catch me.  
I'm the gingerbread man.

**Fox:** Mmm. A gingerbread man. Delicious.  
I'm hungry. I've got a plan.

## Comprehension question

Can Tiger catch the gingerbread man? (no)

This is Fox. Is Fox hungry? (yes)





# The Gingerbread Man

**Gingerbread man:** Run, run as fast as you can.  
You can't catch me.  
I'm the gingerbread man.

**Fox:** Ha ha! Here's the gingerbread man now.

## Comprehension question

Who is here? (Fox/Tiger/the gingerbread man)





# The Gingerbread Man

- Narrator:** The gingerbread man runs and jumps over the wall ...
- Gingerbread man:** Oh no! Help!
- Fox:** Snap! Snap! Snap!
- Gingerbread man:** Ha, ha, hee, hee! You can't catch me.

## Comprehension question

Can Fox catch the gingerbread man? (no)

Can Tiger catch the gingerbread man? (no)






# The Gingerbread Man

**Tiger:** Bad luck, Fox! No gingerbread man for you or for me.

**Fox:** Oh no! It's a tiger. I'm off!

## Comprehension question

Who does Fox see? (Tiger)





# The Gingerbread Man

**Sue:** Hello, Tiger. Look!

**Jay:** Here's a gingerbread man for you.

**Tiger:** Mmm. Delicious! Thank you, Sue. Thank you, Jay.

## Comprehension questions

Do Sue and Jay give Tiger a gingerbread man biscuit? (yes)

Is it delicious? (yes)





# Tiger is Lost

**Jay:** Have you got Tiger, Sue?

**Sue:** Yes, I have. Oh no. No, I haven't. Help me find Tiger, please, Jay.

**Jay:** Yes, of course. Tiger! Tiger!

**Sue:** Oh dear. Tiger is lost.

**Jay:** I know. Let's ask Mum.

## Comprehension questions

Has Sue got Tiger? (no)

Is Tiger lost? (yes)

Who helps Sue find Tiger? (Jay)





# Tiger is Lost

- Sue:** Mum!
- Jay:** Mum!
- Mum:** Not now, children, please. I'm busy.
- Sue:** But Tiger is lost, Mum.
- Jay:** Have you got Tiger?
- Mum:** No, I haven't. Ask your father.

## Comprehension questions

Who do Sue and Jay ask? (Mum)

Is she busy? (yes)

Has she got Tiger? (no)





# Tiger is Lost

- Jay:** Dad!
- Sue:** Dad!
- Dad:** Not now, children, please. I'm busy.
- Jay:** But Tiger is lost, Dad.
- Sue:** Have you got Tiger?
- Dad:** No, I haven't. Ask your grandmother.

## Comprehension questions

Who do Sue and Jay ask? (Dad)

Is he busy? (yes)

Has he got Tiger? (no)





# Tiger is Lost

- Sue:** Granny!
- Jay:** Granny!
- Granny:** Not now, children, please. I'm busy.
- Sue:** But Tiger is lost, Granny.
- Jay:** Have you got Tiger?
- Granny:** No, I haven't. Ask your grandfather.
- Jay:** Have you got Tiger, Grandad?
- Grandad:** No, I haven't. I'm busy, too.

## Comprehension questions

Who do Sue and Jay ask? (Granny and Grandad)

Is Granny busy? (yes)

Has Granny got Tiger? (no)

Is Grandad busy? (yes)

Has Grandad got Tiger? (no)





## Tiger is Lost

**Sue:** Oh dear. I'm worried about Tiger.

**Jay:** Come on. Let's look for Tiger.

**Dad:** Listen. What's that noise?

**Granny:** I think it's Baby.

**Grandad:** But Baby is sleeping ...

**Mum:** I don't know. Let's go and see.

### Comprehension questions

Who thinks the noise is Baby? (Granny)

Who says Baby is sleeping? (Grandad)





# Tiger is Lost

**Mum:** Let's see if Baby is alright.


**Dad:** Quick!

**Granny:** Hurry!

**Grandad:** Come on!

## Comprehension questions

Who goes to Baby's room? (Mum, Dad, Granny, Grandad, Sue, Jay)





# Tiger is Lost

**Mum:** Ahhh, look. Baby is sleeping.

**Grandad:** And look. There's Tiger.

**Jay:** Tiger isn't lost, Sue. He's with Baby.

**Sue:** Thanks, Jay. I'm happy now.

## Comprehension questions

Who's with Baby? (Tiger)

Is Baby really sleeping? (no)

Is Tiger lost now? (no)

Is Sue happy? (yes)





# Tiger is Lost

**Tiger:** Whee! Come on, Baby! This is fun!  
**Sue and Jay:** Oh, Tiger! You are naughty.

## Comprehension questions

Is Baby sleeping now? (no)

Is Tiger sleeping now? (no)

Is Tiger naughty? (yes)





# Dinner Time

**Dad:** It's dinner time. Let's have sausages and peas.

**Jay:** Oh no. I don't like sausages.

**Dad:** Do you like peas?

**Sue:** No, I don't.

**Jay:** Can we have an omelette, please?

**Dad:** Let's see.

## Comprehension questions

What does Dad want for dinner? (sausages and peas)

Does Jay like sausages? (no)

Does Sue like peas? (no)

What do Sue and Jay want? (an omelette)





## Dinner Time

**Dad:** How many eggs have we got?

**Jay:** We've got six.

**Dad:** Good!

**Sue:** And look! We've got ham. I like ham. Put ham in the omelette.

### Comprehension questions

How many eggs have they got? (six)

What else have they got? (ham)

Does Sue like ham? (yes)





## Dinner Time

**Dad:** We've got cheese and potatoes.  
Do you like cheese?

**Sue:** Yes, I do. I love cheese.  
Put cheese in the omelette.

**Dad:** Do you like potatoes?

**Jay:** Yes, I do. I love potatoes!  
Put potatoes in the omelette.

**Dad:** OK. Let's have a cheese,  
ham and potato omelette.

**Sue and Jay:** Yes!

### Comprehension questions

Does Sue like cheese? (Yes, she loves cheese.)

Does Jay like potatoes? (Yes, he loves potatoes.)

What food is in the omelette? (eggs, cheese, ham and potatoes)





## Dinner Time

**Sue:** Mmm. It smells delicious.

**Dad:** OK. Watch this!

### Comprehension question

Does the omelette smell delicious? (yes)





## Dinner Time

- Dad:** One ... two ... three ...
- Sue:** Whoops!
- Jay:** Oh no! The omelette! Catch it, Dad!

### Comprehension question

Can Dad catch the omelette? (no)





## Dinner Time

**Sue:** Oh no, Dad. The omelette.

**Jay:** I'm hungry.

**Sue:** I'm hungry, too.

**Dad:** Oh dear. I'm sorry.

### Comprehension questions

Are Sue and Jay hungry? (yes)

Is Dad sorry? (yes)





## Dinner Time

- Dad:** I've got an idea. Do you like pizza?
- Sue and Jay:** Oh yes, Dad. We love pizza!
- Dad:** Come on. Let's go for a pizza.

### Comprehension questions

What's Dad's idea? (to go for a pizza)

Do Sue and Jay like pizza? (Yes, they love pizza.)





## Dinner Time

**Jay:** I like cheese pizza.

**Sue:** I like ham pizza.


**Tiger:** And I love omelette.

### Comprehension questions

Who likes cheese pizza? (Jay)

Who likes ham pizza? (Sue)

And who loves omelette? (Tiger)





## The Sore Paw

**Narrator:** Tiger is sleeping. He's dreaming he's got a sore paw.

**Tiger:** Ow! I've got a sore paw. Hello, Elephant. Look.  
I've got a sore paw. Can you help me, please?

**Elephant:** No, sorry. I can't. I'm scared of tigers.

**Narrator:** And the elephant goes away as fast as it can.


### Comprehension questions

Is Tiger sleeping? (yes)

He's dreaming he's got a sore ... (paw).

Can the elephant help Tiger? (no)

Why not? (It's scared of tigers.)





## The Sore Paw

**Tiger:** Hello, Giraffe. Look. I've got a sore paw. Can you help me, please?

**Giraffe:** No, sorry. I can't. I'm scared.

**Narrator:** And the giraffe goes away as fast as it can.

### Comprehension questions

Can the giraffe help Tiger? (no)

Why not? (It's scared.)





## The Sore Paw

**Tiger:** Hello, Snake. Look. I've got a sore paw. Can you help me, please?

**Snake:** No, sorry. I can't. I'm scared.

**Narrator:** And the snake goes away as fast as it can.

### Comprehension questions

Can the snake help Tiger? (no)

Why not? (It's scared.)





## The Sore Paw

**Tiger:** Hello, Monkey. Look. I've got a sore paw. Can you help me, please?

**Monkey:** No, sorry. I can't. I'm scared.

**Narrator:** And the monkey goes away as fast as it can.

### Comprehension questions

Can the monkey help Tiger? (no)

Why not? (It's scared.)





## The Sore Paw

**Tiger:** Hello, Mouse. Look. I've got a sore paw. Can you help me, please?

**Mouse:** Yes, of course I can. Oh dear! You've got a thorn in your paw.

### Comprehension question

Can the mouse help Tiger? (yes)





## The Sore Paw

**Narrator:** The mouse pulls ...

**Tiger:** Owww!

**Narrator:** and pulls ...

**Tiger:** Owww!

**Narrator:** ... and the thorn comes out.

**Tiger:** Owww!

### Comprehension question

What does the mouse do? (It pulls and pulls and the thorn comes out.)





## The Sore Paw

**Tiger:** Oh, my paw is better now. Thank you, Mouse.

**Mouse:** You're welcome. Can you help me now, please, Tiger? I'm a long way from home and I can't cross the river.

**Tiger:** Yes, of course I can, Mouse. Jump on my back.

### Comprehension questions

Is Tiger's paw better now? (yes)

Can Tiger help the mouse? (Yes, he can. He can cross the river.)





## The Sore Paw

**Elephant:** Oh, look! The little mouse isn't scared of Tiger.

**Giraffe:** The little mouse and Tiger are friends.

**Snake:** Amazing!

### Comprehension questions

Who's surprised? (the elephant, the giraffe, the snake and the monkey)

Is the little mouse scared? (no)

Are the little mouse and Tiger friends? (yes)





# The Missing Skateboard

- Jay:** This computer game is boring.
- Sue:** Let's play with our skateboards.
- Jay:** Yes, great idea! Come on!

## Comprehension questions

Is the computer game boring? (yes)

What do Sue and Jay want to play with? (skateboards)





# The Missing Skateboard

**Tiger:** Mmm. Skateboard ... I want to play with a skateboard, too.

## Comprehension question

Who else wants to play with a skateboard? (Tiger)





# The Missing Skateboard

**Sue:** I've got my skateboard, Jay. I'm ready!

**Jay:** Oh no! I can't find my skateboard. Where's my skateboard?

**Sue:** Is it in the cupboard?

**Jay:** No, it isn't. The bike is in the cupboard.  
And the scooter is in the cupboard.  
But no skateboard.

## Comprehension questions

Has Sue got her skateboard? (yes)

Can Jay find his skateboard? (no)

What's in the cupboard? (the bike and the scooter)





# The Missing Skateboard

**Sue:** Oh dear. Is it on the shelf?

**Jay:** No, it isn't. The car is on the shelf. And the doll is on the shelf. But no skateboard.

## Comprehension questions

Is Jay's skateboard on the shelf? (No, it isn't.)

What's on the shelf? (the car and the doll)





# The Missing Skateboard

**Sue:** Oh dear. Is it under the table?

**Jay:** No, it isn't. The kite is under the table.

**Sue:** Is it under the chair?

**Jay:** No, it isn't. The board game is under the chair.


## Comprehension questions

Is Jay's skateboard under the table? (No, it isn't.)

What's under the table? (the kite)

Is Jay's skateboard under the chair? (No, it isn't.)

What's under the chair? (the board game)





# The Missing Skateboard

- Sue:** Is your skateboard in the garden?
- Jay:** Yes, it is! Look!
- Sue:** Oh no. Tiger!

## Comprehension questions

Is Jay's skateboard in the garden? (Yes, it is.)

Who's got it? (Tiger)





# The Missing Skateboard

- Tiger:** Hello, Sue! Hello, Jay! Look at me! I'm on the skateboard. I can go very fast! Watch me. It's fun!
- Sue:** Oh no! Be careful, Tiger!
- Jay:** Stop, Tiger! Stop!

## Comprehension questions

Is Tiger on the skateboard? (yes)

Is it fun? (yes)

Can he go very fast? (yes)

What do Sue and Jay say? (*Be careful, Tiger! Stop, Tiger!*)





# The Missing Skateboard

**Sue:** Oh dear. Poor Tiger!

**Jay:** Silly Tiger!

**Tiger:** Ow! My head! I'm sorry, Jay. You can have your skateboard now.

## Comprehension questions

Has Tiger hurt his head? (yes)

What does Tiger say? (*I'm sorry.*)

Can Jay have his skateboard now? (yes)

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
